THESE CLASSES WERE WELL ATTENDED BOTH BY THE WOMEN STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY AND BY WORKING WOMEN. THE SISTERS ALSO ORGANIZED CLASSES AND CLUBS FOR CHILDREN. THE HANDMAIDS ESPECIALLY CHERISHED INSTRUCTING WOMEN AND CHILDREN FOR RECEPTION INTO THE CATHOLIC CHURCH. I am thrilled to be able to share with you the very first *Report on Philanthropic Giving* compiled by the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, USA Province. While future issues will be a one-year report, this first time endeavor includes our fiscal years from 2009-2011.

Since 2005, our USA Province has been working to establish a Development Office in order to focus on expanding our reach and our relationships with the public. Thanks to the efforts of my predecessors, Sisters Gloria Petrone and Sagrario Núñez, when I was named Provincial Superior in 2009, much of the foundation had already been laid. Our Foundress

Saint Raphaela Mary is a gift to the world. Born in Pedro Abad, Spain on March 1, 1850, Raphaela was the youngest of seven children from a prosperous and privileged family, deeply religious in their Catholic faith. On March 25, the Feast of the Annunciation, at the age of fifteen Raphaela made a vow of perpetual chastity to God. In 1875, Raphaela Mary and her older sister, Dolores, began their Consecrated Life. They longed to repair lives and bring all to God, especially poor families and children. Their greatest passion was that all people might experience God's unconditional love. St. Raphaela Mary showed heroic virtues in her desire to always seek reconciliation, never dominance or power. St. Raphaela Mary believed strongly in the power of education to change the world. She died quietly in her room on January 6, 1925; was beatified in 1952 by Pope Pius XII, and canonized on January 23, 1977 by Pope Paul VI.



statue of Saint Raphaela Mary, Foundress of the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, was blessed by Pope Benedict XVI on January 20, 2010. The statue was placed in the exterior of the apse of the Basilica of Saint Peter in Vatican City - a space designated for those who founded religious congregations. It is the only statue of an Andalusian saint to adorn the Basilica.



estimated nine hundred faithful gathered at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Philadelphia to celebrate a Liturgy of Thanksgiving held on Saturday, May 8, 2010.

Honoring the recent placement of Saint Raphaela Mary's statue at the Vatican in Rome, Cardinal Justin Rigali was the principal celebrant and homilist at the liturgy. He was joined by a host of concelebrants, and offered a beautifully inspiring homily reflecting on the life of Saint Raphaela Mary, the foundress of the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Twenty-five Handmaids from Miami, Florida; Atlanta, Georgia; El Salvador, Philadelphia, Haverford, and Wyncote, Pennsylvania took part in the celebration. Invited dignitaries included Camilo Villarino-Marzo, a political counselor at the Spanish Embassy in Washington, DC and Dr. Herminio Muñiz, Honorary Vice Consul for the Consulate of Spain in Philadelphia.

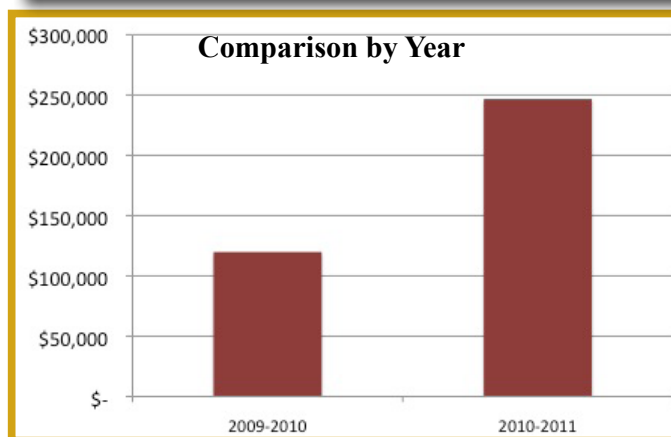
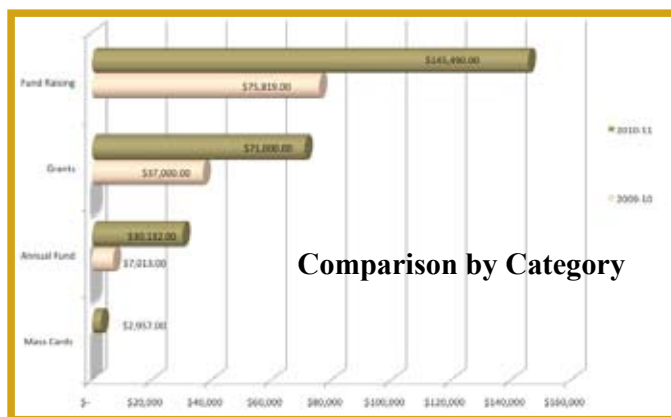

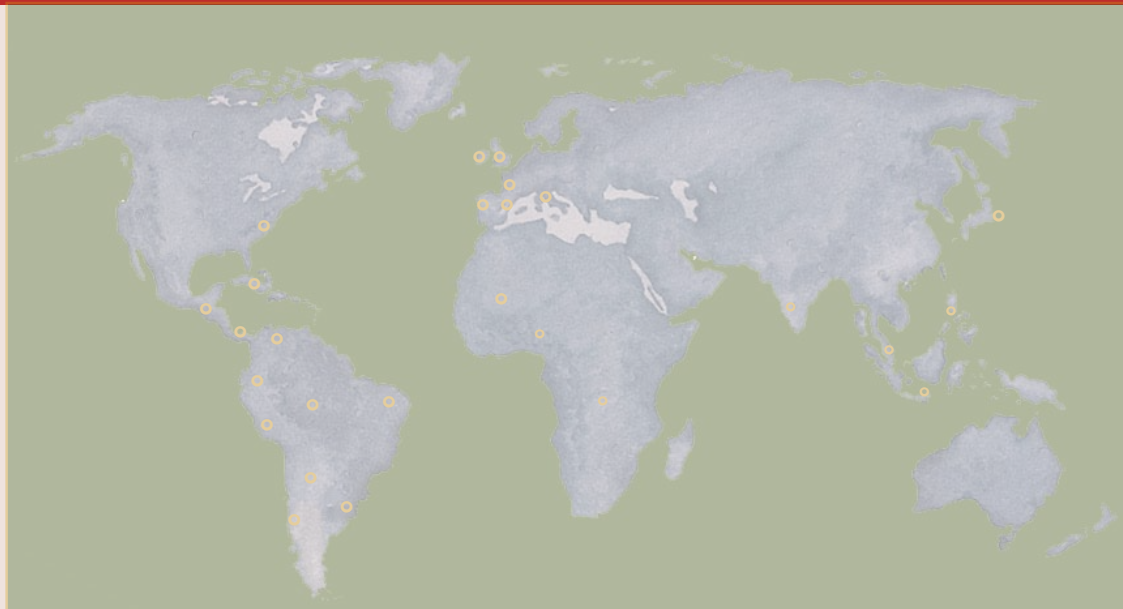
